
As part of this Energy Management Policy, LAIL shall

In order to carry out its operations in an energy efficient manner LAIL will:

- J Implement a regular programme of audits
- J Nominate site representatives to oversee the energy management practices on each project.
- J Identify all cost-effective energy efficiency measures
- J Increase staff awareness
- J Work with clients to develop energy efficiency plan & projects
- J Work with sub-contractors to promote energy management along the supply chain
- J Use 'Whole Life Costing & energy efficiency' models for equipment selection
- J Proactively promote the use of renewable and sustainable energy solutions where practicable.
