To carry out its operations in an energy efficient manner LAIL will:

- Identify cost-effective energy efficiency measures during our project set up phase.
- Procure lower energy intensity plant and materials.
- Work with clients and designers to development energy efficient plans and projects.
- Work with subcontractors to promote energy management through the supply chain.
- Use 'Whole Life Costing and energy efficiency' models for equipment and material selection.
- Proactively promote the use of renewable and sustainable energy solutions where possible.
- Nominate site representatives to oversee the energy management practices on each project.
- Educate staff and supply chain to increase awareness of energy efficiency and climate change
